EXPRESSIONS OF NAKBA is an international competition and exhibition to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the Nakba: the expulsion and dispossession of hundreds of thousands of Palestinians from their homes and land in 1948. The exhibition strives to present the extraordinary narrative of a dispossessed people through a diverse range of expressions from young artists that interpret the collective identity, historic struggle, and emotional experience of the Nakba for Palestinians.

The exhibit showcases the winning entries from the competition in addition to a wonderful range of selections in the form of visual arts, poetry, essays, music, video and digital media.

The exhibit is being held in conjunction with the 2nd Annual Boston Palestine Film Festival. The opening reception includes short film screenings, live Arabic music, food and drinks. Several international filmmakers and artists will be present to speak about how their work relates to the Nakba.

This exhibition is free of charge for students and the general public.
